Cure Kids raise funds to research serious illnesses in Children

600 babies are born with heart defects every year, Leukaemia now has a 90% remission rate, thanks to research from Cure Kids.

Some facts that speak for themselves:-

- -Cure Kids is the 2nd highest medical funder in New Zealand.
- -\$37 million has been invested in research to date
- -101 NZ researchers are supported through grants
- -30 active research grant
- -\$1.1 million raise through Red Nose Day
