-Joined in 1976, 39 years as a Rotarian

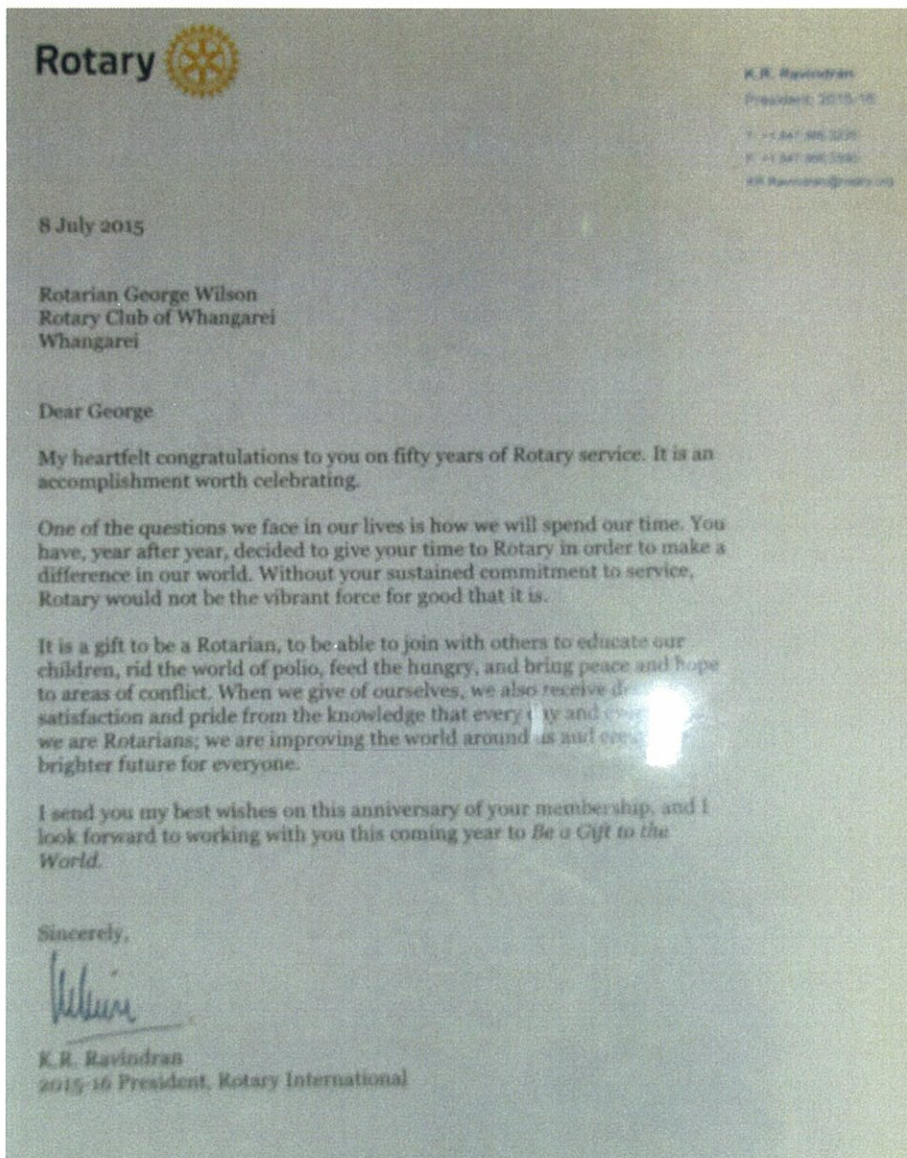
Frank Geddes
